- Description of the event and its activities.

This Work Package event was executed in four connected parts between December and January 2024, precisely on: 18 - 19 December 2023 and 30 January 2024.

The aim of the events, which together constitute WP5 of the project, was to sustain a Network of Towns aiming at active citizenship and promotion of informed participation in the European Elections and to provide training on podcasts because each partner is requested to prepare "one episode" of the podcasts series. It should be done in the form of an interview - live or online, e.g. via zoom. Together all the episodes (one per partner) will become a series "European Union in podcasts – speak up! Podcasts by partners of the Network of Organizations and Towns for the European Elections in the run up to the elections to the European Parliament 2024".

This online event among the NOTE partner network and local stakeholders and our facilitators team for the next European elections was focused on launching from a wide range a open and debate on fears and expectations related to the citizens and democratic engagement on the next European elections and to share tools and other ways to reach audience on this to raise awareness on citizens voices, not only on Sustainable Development Goals and their role for civic engagement but so for an informed debate among the partners and their stakeholders on how communicate and develop local actions to raise citizens awareness. We, as all our partners from the NOTE project, are very committed to take actions to promote this European spirit, engagement and an informed audience and citizenship to act. All the elements of this network are well aware of the difficulties we face today in communicating with citizens on issues relating to European citizenship, trust in European institutions and the work of our elected representatives in Brussels.

So we invited for this specially online seminar, to help the participation of local youngsters, activists, youth leaders and university teachers, that all shared a pragmatic view of the reality with numbers and interesting perspectives for the next campaign for the European Elections participation fears and expectations and some visions of the future of the EU project Interactive, and we finished with a workshop session for FACEES and NOTE project partners about "how to create effective podcasts to promote and disseminate the next European Elections 2024?" with the testimonial facilitated by a local worker and former social media team manager on Facebook Europe.

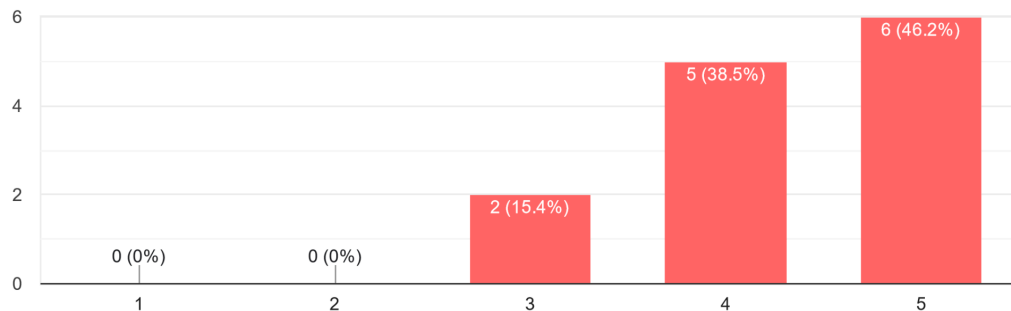
